#### OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Greek copper coin:

Obverse: "George, King of the Greeks" in Greek characters, 1878, surrounding a profile bust of King George

Reverse: "2 lepta" surrounded by two branches of leaves and berries, tied together at the bottom with a bow

this coin has a hole in the middle of the coin, not originally supposed to be there. It is over where King George's nose should be

#### ORIGIN

In 1878, 7.132.400 of these coins were minted in Greece. The modern nation of Greece obtained independence from Ottoman Turkey in 1833. It functioned as a monarchy from that year until 1925 and again from 1935-1974. This coin features the bust of the ruler at the time King George I.
