## OBJECT DESCRIPTION

## ORIGIN

Hull-House was the center of the Greek communitiy in Old Greektown at Halsted and Polk Streets. The Greeks were the largest ethnic group served by Hull-House and participated in all of the programs sponsored by the settlement house.
