ORIGIN

Andrew Calas' real family name was Kalogridakis, they were from Crete. In 1927 he married Chrysanthe Mazokapakis in Havana, Cuba. They settled in Chicago. He was a veteran of WWI and was gassed in the war. He died at Hines Veterans Hospital as a result of this injury.
