Round mahogany canteen with attached wooden stopper, leather handle and edging. X marked on the center of the bullseye shaped pattern on the belly of the canteen. Also the markings: 18761 near the top of one side. Leather strap continues around the outside of the wooden belly.

ORIGIN

Brought to US by Katina Barbatsuly; owned by her father Kosta Gologina. Possibly a Balkan Civil War issue canteen.
