

Geneva, Oct. 2, 1988

Dear Mr. Stora,

I would be delighted to come to Boston and talk a few hours with you personally and all your friends of Nova of course. I am too late to change my program, especially as I am depending on many other people.

At April 16 I am arriving in New York. 15-16-17 meetings with the Greeks, the publisher, the literary agent, the local advisors and my first, personal (public) for Mr. Kaganakis, in Greek in New York on the 16th.

18-19-20-21-22. Zeta = the book - that is I must be able to go for Harold Price who is visiting me with my friend Lady for 9 days! He wants me to speak also to various, governmental, radio, TV etc... I hope I'll be able to - make a few words on peace, etc etc, then speaking on Kaganakis or Zeta.

On April 23, I have to leave for Chicago. On 24 I have public talks on my 16th book of things. On 25 I have to visit my family somewhere near Chicago. Then go on, with her sister, Catherine, and my father to Japan, Long Kong - Cambodia, Nepal, Colorado, Greece.

As you may imagine that is a real busy program for November and is a real bad luck to me. I hope I'll be able to talk to you and speak with them about peace. I have 200 names of tortured persons in Greece. There are many more hundreds, but they are afraid to confess what they have suffered. These 1300 are ready to tell.
