Male figure, black hair and fedora, blue jacket, white shirt, black tie, black pant and shoes, red sash belt, holding 3-d white komboloi, and brown cross? and book?

ORIGIN

Stavrakas-He is the fake bully of the "Manges" subculture. He acts tough but runs from trouble. He was invented by Yannis Moros based on a type of person from the 1920s.
